# 1. Tuition Exemption System

● **Undergraduate students** are not eligible for tuition exemption. (Undergraduates who were enrolled **in AY 2019 or before** are still be able to apply for tuition exemption.)

● **Graduate students** are able to apply for tuition exemption.

● Undergraduate students are able to apply for some funds, such as COVID-19 related special benefits. Make sure to check the **bulletin board** and your **e-mail!**

# University System for Tuition Exemption

	Application Period	Results Notification
First Semester	Late March	Mid-July
Second Semester	Late July to Late September	Mid-January

Depending on the selection process, **full exemption**, **half exemption** or **no exemption** will be granted.

Period	Amount
<b>October to March of following year</b>	<b>¥48,000/month</b>

- ✓ Availability changes every year
- ✓ AY 2020 results → 2 recipients
- ✓ If there is recipient availability, internal selection will occur
- ✓ Notification of applications **around September**

- ✓ Number of recipients changes every year
- ✓ AY 2020 results → **10** recipients
- ✓ Recipients will be selected through internal screening
- ✓ Notification of applications **around January**

Candidates for scholarships that require a university recommendation are selected through internal screening **twice a year**.

Yasuda Scholarship	Required to converse in <b>Japanese</b> (N3 or higher)
Otsuka Scholarship	<b>Japanese or English is OK</b>




